Do you journal? It's not just for school. Some of the greatest, strongest, most successful men -- not just writers -- journal on a regular basis.

It will keep you focused, make you more organized and accountable to yourself, and will keep your thoughts and plans moving along, so you don't forget them or lose track of them.

Journaling will grow one very important skill that will make you more successful in whatever you do: communication! That's right.

One thing is for sure: if you plan to do anything with your life that counts, you will never stop learning, researching, reporting, or becoming a better communicator.

Here are some famous men who were faithful to journal, and it was a big part of the things they

achieved--the things that made their mark on history!

REAL MEN WHO JOURNALED:

AMERICAN EXPLORERS LEWIS & CLARK:

From May 1804 to September 1806, Meriwether Lewis and William Clark led an expedition covering more than 8,000 miles across previously unexplored regions of the American West.

Today, the 18 field journals of Lewis and Clark are held in preservation at the American Philosophical Society in Philadelphia.

WORLD-CHANGING INVENTOR THOMAS EDISON:

The most productive inventor in American history, Thomas Edison was also a prolific note-taker, leaving behind more than 5 million pages at the time of his death in 1931.

LEGENDARY PHYSICIST ALBERT EINSTEIN:

Before his death in 1955, Albert Einstein bequeathed his entire literary estate to Hebrew University in Jerusalem, an institution he helped found in 1925. Among the 80,000 scientific and popular writings, drafts, lecture notes and notebooks were also the famous physicist's travel diaries.¹

LEADER AMONG LEADERS, GENERAL GEORGE S. PATTON

Patton's habit of pocket notebook keeping began after his freshman year at West Point. His first year had not gone well; he struggled with dyslexia and failed mathematics, forcing him to repeat his freshman year in the fall.

He returned to school in 1905 with a steely dedication to be a success this time, and he started a small black leather notebook to help keep himself on track.

He used his notebook to record daily happenings, explore ideas of leadership and war strategy, draw diagrams, and even pen poetry on love. But its most important use was as a place to write down the affirmations and principles that would guide his journey toward his ultimate goal-- becoming a great general.²



THE TENETS

In order to progress as a Man of Honor, you will be required to earn your Tenet pins. They are symbols of your great achievements.

The next few pages will help you understand the requirements and track your progress. Have your leader sign and date in the spaces provided, after you complete each of the requirements.

There are five tenets or achievement levels in the Men of Honor program. For each tenet there is a set of requirements, which once completed, are awarded by an honor pin, worn on the collar. You will be challenged to achieve all five pins in your first year.

TENET ONE: COURAGE

Courage is essential to becoming a Man of Honor. It takes courage to stand for what is right and is a leading factor in a young man's success in the program. Courage is stressed during the teaching times and at all events. It is the call to Courage that appeals to you. This Tenet Pin will require 1-2 months to achieve.

REQUIREMENTS:

(Leader signature and date for each achievement.)

1. Attend a Men of Honor weekend camp

2. Participate in a Courage Challenge Element

3. Complete this Magazine, Modules 1-3

TENET TWO: LEADERSHIP

Leadership is influence. If we are not leading, we are being led.

67% of men's worst fear is public speaking. Many people hide from their potential and destinies because of fear of speaking in public. We will help you overcome this fear. Secondly, you are committed to what you confess. If you make a public proclamation, you are statistically more likely to follow up on your proclamation.

Mentoring is also an indicator of success. Early on we establish mentor relationships in your life. We believe that if it is stressed enough, it will form a pattern that lasts. You will mentor and be mentored.

REQUIREMENTS:

(Leader signature and date for each achievement.)

1. Lead 2 Men of Honor sessions:

2. Mentor one younger student and be mentored by one older student.

3. Demonstrate your personal leadership within your group for 6 months.



TENET THREE: CHARACTER

Character is the sum of moral qualities and values you possess. It is the inner compass that guides you to do the right thing. Character is what distinguishes mediocre men from great men. Character can be shaped and molded, but once you let it set, it is hard to change.

The greater your character, the greater the man you will become. Men of Honor are men who show character not only when others are looking, but in their private lives as well.

REQUIREMENTS:

(Leader signature and date for each achievement.)

1. Read the story of Daniel and complete a Bible Character profile report. (3-5 pages)

2. Demonstrated character (1 or less disciplinary items for the year.)

3. Make a confession of Faith in Christ

TENET FOUR: COMPASSION

Men of Honor are encouraged to use the creativity God gave them to find ways to show compassion to the needy. The measure of a man is his service to others. In order to get your compassion pin you must find an existing project or invent your own service project to help others.

REQUIREMENTS:

(Leader signature and date for each achievement.)

1. Two (2) Approved Service Projects

EXAMPLES:

Food drive leader of project to organize or assist with raising food for the needy. (Any amount) or Toy drive leader: Organize or assist with gathering Christmas presents for the needy. (Any amount)

TENET FIVE: DILIGENCE

A true Man of Honor keeps his commitments, and works diligently to uphold his responsibilities. Learning to be self disciplined in all areas of your life will make you dependable, honorable, and successful.

REQUIREMENTS:

(Leader signature and date for each achievement.)

1. Obtain a set grade point average (locally established level)

2. Two (2) or less attendance items (School)

- Two (2) or less attendance item (Men of Honor)

3. Memorize "the Fellowship of the Unashamed." (as quoted on the opposite page)

SERVANT LEADERSHIP

Everyone wants to be the leader, but here is something the world does not teach us: that being a REAL leader means putting others first, and yourself last.

It means being confident enough to step back and let someone else have the spotlight. It means having the self control to say, no, that's OK, you can have the last piece of pizza, or the next turn at being goalie or quarterback...It means being able to give up whatever it is that you really want for someone else's good. It means being MAN enough to say, you go ahead.

One day, Jesus even set his own disciples straight about this.


MARK 9:33 After they arrived at Capernaum and settled in a house, Jesus asked his disciples, "What were you discussing out on the road?" 34 But they didn't answer, because they had been arguing about which of them was the greatest. 35 He sat down, called the twelve disciples over to him, and said, "Whoever wants to be first must take last place and be the servant of everyone else."

Being a servant leader is the ultimate way to follow the example of Christ.

He tried to show his disciples this when he humbled himself to wash their feet -- the job of the lowest of the lowest servant jobs--and finally, when he really, painfully put himself last by laying down his life on the cross.



All winners are planners. Great achievements won't happen in your life by accident-- you have to plan, and stick to your plan. Use this space to set some goals for yourself. Set dates for completing each task, and work hard to meet each goal.



COMMISSIONING



Once you have completed all three Men of Honor magazines and have the recommendation from your commander, you are eligible to be "partially commissioned" and enter the Honor Guard.

The commissioning ceremony is a very powerful "rite of passage" ceremony that is very similar to the knighting ceremony used in medieval times. You will be honored among your peers and parents and given a dagger (representing the knight's sword) with a personalized nameplate to reward you for your Discipline. It is a rite of passage and should be a separate and more formal meeting.

Once you have completed the partial commissioning, you may begin your Honor Guard requirement and then begin the six required books for full commissioning.

When all three Men of Honor magazines and six Men of Honor curriculum books are completed, the Honor Guard student is eligible for "full commissioning" where you will receive a sword and commission to make disciples of men.

Think about what an accomplishment that would be -- there are few Men of Honor who are man enough to finish the partial commissioning challenge, and even fewer who

make it to the very top -- to be fully commissioned. This is the goal and purpose Christ left for us -- to go into all the world and preach the gospel. It is the Great Commission.
